## IMC Now in VA's T4NG \$22B Acquisition Program

Dulles, VA – [Innovative Management Concepts, Inc. \(IMC\)](#), an information technology services and solutions provider, has received a novated award that provides the company a valuable spot in the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Transformation Twenty-One Total Technology Next Generation (T4NG) acquisition program.

T4NG is a Multi-Agency (MAC) Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Multiple Award Task Order (MATO) contract with a base ordering period of five years and one five-year option period, with a program ceiling of \$22.3 billion. The contract is managed by VA's Technology Acquisition Center in Eatontown, New Jersey. T4NG is an acquisition program for information technology infrastructure improvements, cyber security, and operations and network management – all core capabilities of IMC.

The T4NG contracts were awarded to 28 companies in 2016. Both Leidos Inc. and Systems Made Simple (wholly owned subsidiary of Lockheed Martin) were recipients of a T4NG award. In August 2016, Leidos Inc. and certain businesses of Lockheed Martin merged which resulted in the merged company (Leidos Inc.) having two T4NG contracts. Pursuant to a business transaction between IMC, one of the Leidos T4NG vehicles was subsequently novated to IMC.

IMC has been supporting the VA as a prime contractor and subcontractor since 2007 on multiple Office of Information and Technology, Veterans Benefits Administration, Veterans Health Administration, Board of Veterans Appeals, and VA Construction and Facilities Management projects. IMC provides the VA with software quality assurance, software development, web services, IT technical services, and project management services.

IMC's founder and president, Dr. Robert Might, noted that, "Not only does IMC's access to the T4NG vehicle allow us to provide our core services to the Government for mission-critical support to America's Veterans and their families, but this novation further solidifies our excellent relationship with Leidos both now and into the future."
